LaptopConnect users have a choice of three different devices that can be authorized with a service plan:

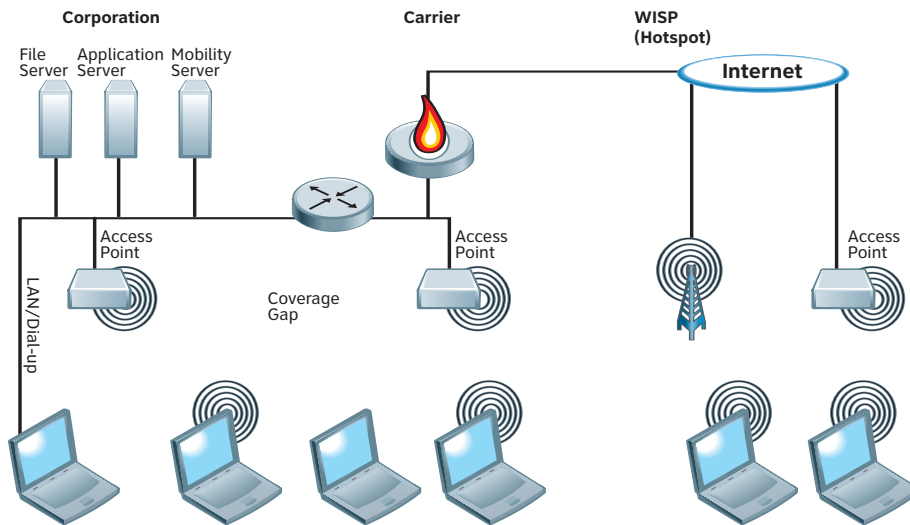
- LaptopConnect cards – Connecting is as easy as plugging a LaptopConnect card into the side of a laptop

Ideal for Point of Care Health Workers

Staying in touch is particularly important for health care workers, especially when providing patient care remotely. With LaptopConnect, for example, home health workers can access the same information resources and tools whether they are in a hospital or at a patient's residence. A mobile solution gives them the ability to track, manage and document patient care in real time – rather than store case files on their laptops and then search for a hotspot to transfer data.

And imagine a paramedic dispatched to the scene of a car accident and needs to stay in contact with a hospital via a laptop on the ambulance dashboard. The paramedic inputs the information – but then loses coverage

while driving through a tunnel. AT&T has an agreement with NetMotion Wireless, Inc., to use its Mobility XE solution, so that LaptopConnect users can reliably connect through a Virtual Private Network (VPN) to their corporate network. Mobility XE also provides "session persistence," so even if the driver loses the signal, he can continue to work offline and once he comes back into an area of coverage, the connection is there; he won't have to log in again.
