Using the AT&T Connect add-in for Microsoft Skype® for Business

You can use the add-in to:

- Meet Now Using AT&T Connect
- Schedule an AT&T Connect Conference
- Invite to an AT&T Voice Conference

The add-in uses your default calendar and email application to send invitations to new conferences.

- The contact/s you chose to invite to the conference already appear in the "To" field of the email message.
- The email message includes all the information the contacts need to be able to access and join the AT&T Connect conference.

Note: You must have an AT&T Connect user account to be able to host meetings.

Invite contacts to an AT&T conference

- 1. In the Contacts list, right-click on one or more contacts.
- 2. From the menu, click one of the options:
 - Meet Now Using AT&T Connect
 - Schedule an AT&T Connect Conference
 - Invite to an AT&T Voice Conference


Inviting conversation participants to an AT&T Connect conference

You can also invite people to AT&T Connect conferences within a conversation. The following procedure applies to a conversation with one other person, a pre-defined group, or participants you added just for this conversation.


- In the conversation window, click the More Options button in the bottom left-hand of the window.
